My inspiration for the work
was of a spiritual nature
based on scriptural references.

The poles that are used within
the work are integral to the design
and structure of the work and
symbolic of the belief and values
inherent in the community.

Journey was originally created in 2012
for UVU's Contemporary Dance Ensemble (CDE).

is a reconstruction of the work
for the CDE Ricochet Concert in 2019.
